Strategies and Tactics for Initial Company Operations
(STICO)
March 20th-21st, 2025

This two-day course is designed to meet the needs of Company Officers (COs) responsible for managing the operations of one or more companies during structural firefighting operations. This course is designed to develop the management skills needed by COs to accomplish assigned tactics at structure fires. With the real possibility of being the first to arrive at an incident, the CO's initial decisions will have an impact throughout the entire incident. It is vital that COs be able to make good management decisions that have a favorable impact on the eventual outcome. In addition to a possible role as the initial Incident Commander, the CO may well be assigned a subordinate position within the Incident Command System organization. This course is an excellent review for experienced Company Officers. Coffee and tea will be provided. Each class date will run from 0900-1600 hours with a 45-minute lunch break.
