In this course, students will discuss current trends and issues that affect the mid-level officer including budgeting, employee - development, discipline, evaluation and motivation, succession planning, communication, and the managing officer's role in training, prevention, investigation, and community outreach. The course is taught in an open discussion format that requires student engagement and learning through practical scenarios and activities.
